Vedanti Bahuddeshiya Sevabhavi Sanstha Andhali (VBSSA) is a registered non-profit organization committed to the holistic upliftment of marginalized and underserved communities across Maharashtra. Established on **24th December 2009** under the Society Registration Act, 1860 (MH/Gad No. 279/2009) and the Bombay Public Trust Act, 1950 (F-5506, dated 20th February 2010), VBSSA has been a steadfast force of change in some of the most remote and socially vulnerable regions of the country.

Headquartered in **Andhali, Taluka Kurkheda, District Gadchiroli**, our work is rooted in the belief that every individual — regardless of caste, class, gender, or circumstance — deserves access to dignity, opportunity, and a life of purpose. For over a decade, we have worked tirelessly at the grassroots level to address the pressing challenges of poverty, illiteracy, social inequality, and health deprivation.

We envision a society where peaceful coexistence thrives across all classes and communities — a society built on the pillars of sustainable development, equal opportunity, and human dignity. We believe that knowledge is the most powerful tool for change, and we strive every day to put that tool in the hands of those who need it most.

Initiatives

Education

VBSSA has established schools and colleges to provide **primary, secondary, and higher education** to underprivileged children. We run awareness campaigns to promote the importance of literacy and inspire young minds to rise above circumstance through knowledge. Our goal is to ensure that no child's future is compromised because of where they were born.



Health & Wellness

Understanding that health is the foundation of all progress, we organize comprehensive **diagnostic and health awareness programs** across rural and tribal areas. Our health initiatives include:

- Medical education and health awareness camps
- AIDS and Cancer Control Programs
- Bird Flu and Swine Flu awareness drives
- Family planning and welfare programs
- National Rural Health Mission implementation
- De-addiction and mental health support

Women's Welfare

VBSSA places the empowerment of women at the centre of its mission. In collaboration with the Department of Human Resource Development, we organize programs that address **women's education, employment, healthcare, and safety**. Our efforts extend to protecting women from exploitation, supporting adolescent girls, caring for pregnant women, and providing shelter to widows and homeless women — because an empowered woman builds an empowered nation.





Initiatives

Child Welfare

Every child deserves love, safety, and a chance to thrive. VBSSA conducts welfare programs for children and infants through orphanage construction, health education, immunization drives, and child development initiatives that nurture young lives from the very beginning.



Rural Development

In a rapidly urbanizing world, VBSSA refuses to let rural communities be left behind. We have transformed remote villages by improving **basic infrastructure** — from drainage and water management systems to road upgradation and healthcare access. We have constructed and continue to operate schools, colleges, free dispensaries, feeding centres for the poor, and homes for the elderly — all with the singular aim of bridging the rural-urban divide.

Land & Water Management

Aligned with Government of India policies, VBSSA implements sustainable practices in **land and water conservation**, including watershed management, rainwater harvesting, water recharging, irrigation systems, and flood control and disaster relief operations.





Initiatives

SC, ST & Backward Classes Welfare

VBSSA actively conducts welfare programs for Scheduled Castes, **Scheduled Tribes, and Other Backward Classes**, focusing on education, employment, and healthcare access. We organize technical training sessions, seminars, awareness campaigns, and community workshops to create equitable opportunities for historically disadvantaged communities.



Welfare for Disableds

Our disability welfare programs are designed to support individuals with physical, visual, mental, and other challenges. We collaborate with the Disability Welfare and Social Justice Departments to run **special schools, employment-generation programs, assistive device distribution**, leprosy control initiatives, and rehabilitation awareness drives.

Urban Development

VBSSA extends its reach to urban slums, working to ensure **sanitation, clean drinking water, educational access, women's safety, and livelihood training** for residents. We also actively participate in civic development planning, collaborating with urban local bodies and municipal institutions to promote inclusive urban growth.

Sports & Youth Welfare

We believe in the power of sport to discipline, inspire, and build character. VBSSA organizes **sports training programs, adventure camps, youth welfare initiatives**, and physical education programs, along with employment awareness drives that channel the energy of youth into productive avenues.



Tourism & Cultural Development

VBSSA celebrates India's rich cultural heritage through **dance, drama, puppet-making workshops, seminars, and cultural events**. We also work to protect national monuments and promote local heritage and tourism development, ensuring that culture remains a living, breathing force in community life.

Minority Welfare

True to our inclusive ethos, VBSSA runs welfare programs for minority communities — including Muslim, Sikh, Buddhist, Jain, and Parsi communities — through **educational institutions, job training programs, and awareness seminars** that promote equal opportunity and social harmony.





Initiatives

Village Industries & Livelihood

To tackle rural unemployment at its root, VBSSA facilitates the establishment of **small and large-scale industries in rural areas**, supporting artisans and entrepreneurs through Khadi Village Industries Board loans and other financial linkages. We also promote traditional handicrafts, vocational education, and rural entrepreneurship.



COVID-19 Relief

When the pandemic brought the nation to its knees, VBSSA rose to the occasion. We contributed **₹51,000** to the District Aid Fund of Gadchiroli through the Hon'ble District Magistrate's office and directly supported countless families with essential survival necessities — because compassion has no lockdown.





Flagship Centres

Vedanti Integrated Rehabilitation Centre

Established in **2009** as a **De-addiction Centre** and upgraded in 2016 into a **15-Bedded Treatment-cum-Rehabilitation Centre**, this facility has been a lifeline for individuals battling substance abuse across Gadchiroli district. With a dedicated team of **15 staff members**, the centre provides completely **free-of-cost treatment** including medical care, counselling, yoga, exercise, nutritious meals, and a serene garden environment designed for healing.

Our social workers travel village to village, conducting street plays, rallies, and one-on-one counselling to reach those most at risk — bringing them back from the edge and guiding them toward a healthier, addiction-free life.

Operated since **2010** at Hanuman Ward, Chandrapur Road, Gadchiroli, our **Senior Citizens' Home** provides shelter, care, and community to **50 elderly women** from the SC community — many of whom are without family support. Through regular health camps, dementia day-care programs, Ayurvedic and Homeopathic guidance camps, and SHG programs, we ensure that our elders spend their final years with dignity, care, and companionship.
